Emergency Preparedness & Resilience through the Health IT Infrastructure

- Progress & align standards-based interoperability: Direct, C-CDA
 - Leverage the eHealthExchange & S&I Framework SDC Initiative
- Establish API/EHR open architecture integration
 - Link emergency preparedness centers (state/fed gov) with ERs/ emergency responders
 - Create minimum "content" & "transport" standard as well as best practice guidelines for interoperability and scalability
- Expand mobile EHRs, patient portals & PHRs (Blue Button®)
- Create national patient identifier/data linking
 - CommonWell Health Alliance priority
- Discourage state & local proprietary standards & interfaces



From ARRA to ACA Framework for HIT Resilience

- ACA Health Center Controlled Networks \$21 million, 43 networks
 - To support EHR and meaningful use adoption; opportunity to instill resilient infrastructure (Direct, C-CDA, Blue Button®)
- ARRA HIE Cooperative Agreement Program \$564M
 - Funded state, regional HIEs now forming preparedness and response networks
 - Southeast Regional HIT and HIE Collaboration (SERCH)
 - Network of 10 HIEs: care coordination, emergency and disaster recovery
 - Michigan Health Connect HIE (67 hospitals, 1600 practices): linkage with EMS, Fire Depts
 - All utilizing Direct protocols (meaningful use Stage 2 standard)



Further Leveraging the Affordable Care Act

- ACA Patient Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) - ~\$5B
 - Includes funding to establish data infrastructures to create,
 disseminate and implement research evidence and practices
 - Encourage PCORI research on emergency healthcare and IT
 - Use Cases with PPRNs & CDRNs
- ACA Prevention and Public Health Fund ~\$10B through FY19
 - Stated goals (in part): Public Health Research and Tracking; Lab and Immunization Expansion
 - Bridge with PCORI Research RFPs



Bridging National Preparedness & Prevention Priorities

Influenza Immunizations and Registries EHRs & Public Health

Opportunities:

- ACA Prevention and Public Health Fund
 - Immunization expansion goal
- ONC/CDC Public Health-EHR Vendor Collaboration Initiative (expand beyond meaningful use Stage 2 compliance)
- Expand influenza reporting through the EHR to CDC's ILINet

Barriers:

 Lack of comprehensive Syndromic Surveillance standards in meaningful use Stage 2 for ambulatory setting
